

POINTS TO KNOW IF YOU ARE CHOSEN TO SERVE

First, if you have been confirmed as a staff member for any director but you become unable to come to camp, please immediately let the director know so that he can fill your position early. **DO NOT WAIT UNTIL CHECK-IN DAY TO ADVISE US.**

On opening day (Sunday afternoon) plan to be at camp **BY 2:00** so that you can be in place and ready to meet campers and their families as they come in. Staff members **must** be inside the cabins to greet our families as they arrive. Parents want to **SEE** the faces of those who will be caring for their child **NOT an empty cabin**. If you have an emergency on check-in day and will be late, please phone your director or call the camp office at 334-684-2118.

On Sunday afternoon, Nurse/Medical Professions are to be inside the check-in location before **check-in BEGINS** so they will be able to receive medications and speak with parents concerning campers' medical needs. Remember, we require a copy of license/certification for all nurse/medical to come on staff at camp.

Bring a copy of your health insurance card to carry with you during the week.

All staff positions are voluntary appointments made by and headed by the director. Under the director, the chain of command is: Village leaders (Chief and Queen) who assist the director; followed by nurse/medical professionals, cabin leaders and counselors. Jointly, staff members are responsible for the safety, well-being and best interest of our campers.

Be aware that in addition to your speech and actions, your manner of dress is very significant to our campers. Please view the **"Things to Pack"** camp link on the Camp Info page and plan to pack accordingly as our dress code **does apply to staff** as well as campers. In general, modest clothing; not tightly fitting with hemlines no shorter than 2 inches above the knee, clean wording/graphics with waist/tummies covered.

Please also remember that what you do reflects on Camp Wiregrass and the mission we live for. Your conduct, your attitude and your cooperation skills are not only being seen by the director, other staff members, campers and parents; they are also being reviewed from above (WWJD).

Prepare to serve by getting plenty of rest before you come and by planning to make our campers your top priority. Resolve to be a good role model and team member for campers and other staff members alike.
